Dartmouth is New Hampshire's eighth largest service sector employer with more than \$500M in payroll.



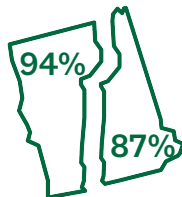

Approximately **50% of undergrads** receive financial aid with an average award of **\$51K annually**
